UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel appearing
 for the parties.

2. In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order allowing payment of salary to respondent nos. 3 and 4.

3. It is then argued by the learned ASG appearing for the petitioners that there are a large number of employees, who have been illegally appointed by the concerned Society and the present dispute is only in respect of respondent nos. 3 and 4 whereas, for the remaining large number of illegally appointed employees, prayer for interim relief has been rejected by the High Court.

4. Be that as it may, the order for grant of salary shall remain confined to respondent nos. 3 and 4 purely as an interim measure, and we request the High Court to take up the writ petition for early disposal.

5. It will remain open for the petitioners to apply before the High Court, after complying with the impugned order, seeking vacation/ modification of the impugned order.

6. With the above observations/
directions, the special leave petition is
disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any,
shall stand disposed of.
