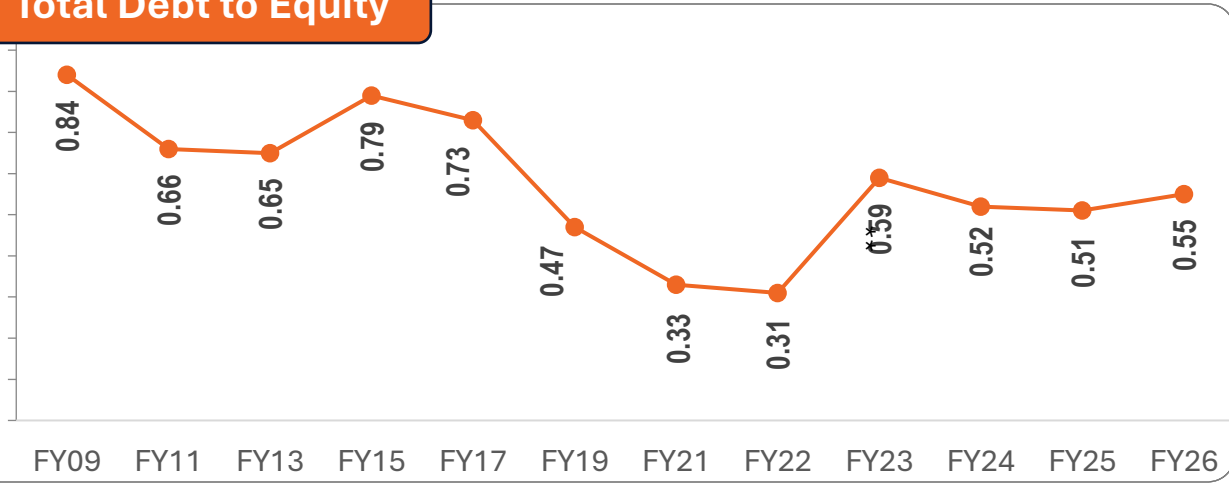
Net Sales (USD Mil)
