[^] YoY Change - Muted growth in traffic (specifically International traffic) was attributable to temporary disruptions in flight operations, which were caused by evolving airspace conditions amid persistent geopolitical events and a challenging macroeconomic climate. Similarly, subdued domestic traffic growth reflects broader, industry-wide constraints stemming from the current macroeconomic environment.

Airport traffic in India has faced compounding impacts from ongoing geopolitical instability in the Middle East since 28 Feb'26. Despite these global systemic challenges, the domestic aviation sector is actively navigating operational headwinds to maintain connectivity and structural resilience.

Medan airport domestic traffic has been affected by supply-side constraints as a portion of the aircraft fleet remains grounded due to maintenance-related issues - a challenge currently impacting the broader Indonesian aviation market

Key Highlights for Jun'26 & Q1 FY27[^]

- **Traffic Resilience at GMR Airports:** Served ~10 mn Pax in Jun'26 across all portfolio airports (marginal decline of 0.03 mn or 0.3% YoY)
 - Domestic Traffic: 7.4 mn (down slightly by 0.03 mn or 0.4% YoY)
 - International Traffic: 2.4 mn (up 0.1% YoY/almost flat in absolute no.)

 - **Stakeholders Consultation Meeting (06 Jul 2026):** AERA convened meeting was held on 06 Jul'26 to elicit the views of the stakeholders on the proposals made in the Consultation Paper
 - Following the discussions, AERA requested all participating stakeholders to submit their written comments/views /suggestions by 20 Jul'26
