O R D E R
(Hybrid Mode)

20.08.2026: These are Contempt Petitions filed since it is alleged the Respondents are acting in violation of order dated 17.03.2026 passed by learned NCLT, Chandigarh as well as order dated 29.05.2026 passed by this Tribunal. The matter relates to the insolvency of Majestic Hotels Ltd., the Corporate Debtor which runs five-star hotel property namely Hotel Majestic Park Plaza at Ludhiana being operated by M/s Sarovar Hotels Pvt. Ltd. since 1996. It is submission of learned counsel for the Applicant that this five-star hotel certain properties on different floors, still in the possession of members of suspended management and also through M/s Tru Prime Private Limited. The details of such premises in possession of the suspended management are given in the application viz. *I.A. No.2486 of 2024* filed before the learned NCLT.

2. The learned NCLT *vide* order dated 17.03.2026 has allowed application *I.A. No.2486 of 2024* filed by the Resolution Professional and had directed the

suspended management to handover the possession of the salon in second floor, 13 shops in third floor, 5 rooms i.e. No.1802 to 1806 on the 8th floor used for residence by Ms. Amandeep Khangura and the 9th floor portion used as such by R-1 and R-4 and their families as residence, within a period of two weeks from the date of pronouncement of the order. Two appeals were filed before this Tribunal being Company Appeal (AT) (Ins.) Nos.686 of 2026 and 801 of 2026. Both appeals were dismissed and two weeks' further time was granted to the Respondents to vacate the premises. The said period of two weeks expired on 12.06.2026 and even till date the possession is not handed over.

3. Let notice be issued in these Contempt Petitions to the Respondents. Dasti service of notice is also allowed.

4. List these Contempt Petition on **15.09.2026** high on board.
