UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. We are informed that at least 77 writ appeals touching similar issues are pending consideration before the High Court. Earlier, the matter was heard by an appropriate Division Bench of the High Court, but prior to the delivery of the judgment, one of the Hon'ble Judges demitted his office.
2. Under the circumstances, we request the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court of Andhra Pradesh to immediately take up the matter herself or constitute a Bench for hearing of all such matters, to be decided on an expeditious basis. Even if all the matters cannot be heard together, be it for whatever reasons, then at least the main matter i.e. Writ Appeal No. 1058 of 2022 can be segregated and heard on expeditious basis.

3. We clarify that pendency of the present appeal or the contentions raised before us, would not come in the way of the High Court in independently deciding the matter on its own merits.

4. List the matter on 15.07.2026.

5. The outcome of the writ appeal be made known to us before the next date of hearing.
