A W A R D

1. Heard Mr.Dhiraj Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, Ms. Sakshi Mittal, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd along with Mr. Sahil Gupta, Chief Manager.

2. There is an agreement between the parties. The terms are that over and above what has been awarded by the High Court, the respondent-insurance company will pay a consolidated amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) within a period of six weeks.

3. The petitioners shall furnish the account details to the insurance company. After receipt of the account details and on due verification, the amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh) shall be transferred to the petitioner(s) within a period of six weeks from today.

4. The petitioners agree that on receipt of the consolidated amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs) over and above the amount awarded by the High Court, the petitioners will have no further claim against the insurance company.

5. The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.

6. We record our appreciation for Mr. Dhiraj Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Ms. Sakshi Mittal, learned counsel appearing for the respondent for their spontaneous and positive response and initiative taken to resolve the dispute between the parties.
