ORDER

1. By these Miscellaneous Applications, the office has placed on record a letter dated 10th June, 2026 of the Joint Registrar (for Registrar, NCLT, Mumbai).
2. Paragraph 2 of such letter reads as follows:

“In compliance of directions of Hon’ble Supreme Court, the parties were directed to appear before NCLT Mumbai Bench Court IV on 19.03.2026. Meanwhile, the Original Applicants had filed an IA (Company Act) No. 106/2026 for seeking amendment of CP No. 159/(MB)/2021. The IA (Company Act) No. 106/2026 came up for consideration on 30.03.2026. Therefore, the IA (Company Act) No. 106/2026 was to be decided and disposed of first, before taking up the Original Company Petition I.e. C.P. No 159/(MB)/2021. In compliance of directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court, the matter has been heard extensively on day to day basis and IA (Company Act) No. 106/2026 has been allowed on 01.06.2026. C.P. No. 159/(MB)/2021 has been listed on for hearing on 24.06.2026 for final hearing after carrying out amendments, as allowed; serving copies to the Respondents; and to complete pleadings. Upon completion of the pleadings by the end of June, 2026, and hearing of the parties NCLT Mumbai Bench Court IV will be able to render its final orders in these matters within one month specifically in July 2026. A copy of order dated 01.06 2026 is enclosed.”

3. We are informed by Mr. Kunal Chatterjee, learned counsel for the appellant - Moniveda Consultants LLP - that the National Company Law

Tribunal¹, Mumbai has closed hearing of the matter before it and reserved its judgment on 4th August, 2026 while granting liberty to the parties to file their written submissions by 14th August, 2026.

4. In such view of the matter, we dispose of the Miscellaneous Applications with a request to the NCLT to render its decision, according to law, as early as possible and preferably by 31st October, 2026.

5. Consequently, M.A. Nos. 2558-2559/2026 stand disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
