GMR Airports - Traffic Data: May 2026



Key Highlights for May'26^

- Traffic Resiliency at GMR Airports:** Served ~11 mn Pax in May'26 across all portfolio airports (▲ 0.6 mn or 6.1% YoY)
 - Domestic Traffic: 8.3 mn (▲ 0.6 mn or 7.9% YoY)
 - International Traffic: 2.4 mn (▲ 0.01 mn or 0.4% YoY)
 - Monthly Traffic sustainably remained ~10.0 mn Pax since Oct'25
 - Long-Term Growth Vectors (May'26):* 5-year Total Pax CAGR of ~8.8%, driven by international traffic expansion at a CAGR of ~12.5%

^ YoY Change - Muted growth in traffic (specifically International traffic) was attributable to temporary disruptions in flight operations, which were caused by shifting airspace conditions amid a series of continuing geopolitical events and the current macro-economic situation

Airport traffic in India has been impacted by ongoing geopolitical instability in the Middle East since 28 Feb'26. Despite these global systemic challenges, India's Aviation sector is actively navigating operational headwinds to maintain connectivity and resilience

Medan airport domestic traffic has been affected by supply-side constraints as a portion of the aircraft fleet remains grounded due to maintenance-related issues - a challenge currently impacting the broader Indonesian aviation market

- Regulatory Update#:
 - Bhogapuram International Airport has been declared as a 'Major Airport' by AERA on 29 Aug'25
 - First Control Period of 5 year will be from 01 Apr'27 to 31 Mar'32
- Work progressing steadily on multiple fronts & nearing completion:
 - Airside works (~100% complete), Terminal Building (~99.3% complete) and Air Traffic Control tower (~98.9% complete) progressing simultaneously
 - **~99.4% overall progress achieved as of 31 May'26**
