1. The instant application has been filed seeking the following reliefs:

*“a. condone delay of 35 days in filing the rejoinder dated 24.06.2026 filed vide E-Filing No.0710102030252026/3 by the Applicant to the Respondents' reply to the contempt petition and take the same of record;*

*b. pass any other order or orders as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”*
