13.05.2026: CA (AT) (Ins) No. 717 of 2026

1. **I.A. No. 3306 of 2026** is filed by the successful bidder one of the aircraft of Jet Airways. The learned Counsel, on instructions, submits that he is withdrawing his application bearing I.A. No. 3306 of 2026. The same is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.

I.A. No. 3464 of 2026 is filed by the eight financial creditors of the corporate debtor for intervening in this appeal. The learned Counsel is required to serve the copy of the I.A. on the appellant as well as on the liquidator.

The first respondent, liquidator seeks short time to file reply to the appeal in CA (AT)(Ins) No. 717 of 2026. He is permitted to do so.

CA (AT) (Ins) No. 522 & 523 of 2026: Pleadings are complete.

2. The counsel for the appellant submits that there is a batch of appeals in CA (AT)(Ins) Nos. 375/2026, 419/2026, 420/2026, 440/2026 and 551/2026 which are now pending before the Hon'ble Chairperson Court for consolidation of the appeals.

3. Registry is now required to place the matter before Hon'ble Chairperson for appropriate orders.

4. On 19.03.2026, this Tribunal has passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the liquidator has submitted that no distribution of the amount shall take place without leave of the Court.”
