UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

ORDER

1. Delay condoned.
2. Heard Ms. Haripriya Padmanabhan, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners. Though we are not in agreement with the reasoning rendered by the High Court in allowing the writ appeal,

particularly on the ground that principles of natural justice have been violated, in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

3. However, the question of law, raised by Ms. Haripriya Padmanabhan is kept open for being considered in an appropriate case. It is also clarified that the judgment shall not be treated as precedent.
