Chakalabbi, learned counsel for the Insurance Company, Mrs. Santosh Chaudhary, Mr. Surya Kant and Mr. Akarsh Deepak representing the Insurance Company, for the positive attitude displayed by them in bringing an amicable end

to the dispute in this matter.

9. The matter stands disposed of as having been settled.
