05/12.06.2026 The present contempt petition has been filed for initiating a contempt proceeding against the contemnors/opposite parties alleging wilful violation of the order dated 05.02.2025 passed in W.P.(C) No. 6630 of 2024.

2. Mr. Ashutosh Anand, learned AAG-III appearing on behalf of the opposite party no. 2, submits that the order dated 05.02.2025 passed in W.P.(C) No. 6630 of 2024 has now been complied. He also files compliance affidavit on behalf of the opposite party no. 2.

3. Considering the said submission, there is no need to further proceed in the contempt petition. The contempt proceeding as against the opposite party no. 2 is hereby dropped.

4. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.

5. The petitioner is, however, at liberty to take appropriate recourse as permissible under law for redressal of its subsisting grievance.

6. Pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
