UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have perused the Fourth Status Report, dated 24.07.2026, submitted by the learned *Amicus Curiae*. One of the directions prayed for in the Report is to direct the consortium of lender-Banks, led by the Union Bank of India, to release the agreed-upon amount of Rs. 25 crores, apart from sanctioning *interim* finance up to Rs. 100 crores for Supertech Realtors Private Limited (in short, 'SRPL') forthwith.
2. Moreover, the learned *Amicus Curiae* submits that on 08.06.2026, representatives of the consortium Banks, in a meeting with the Empowered Committee, voluntarily agreed to release Rs. 25 crores in five tranches of Rs. 5 crores each.

3. It seems to us that the release of these funds is essential to the continuation of work on the project, but the same remains uncredited solely due to the Banks awaiting a formal order by this Court.

4. In these circumstances we find it appropriate to direct the consortium of Banks to release a sum of Rs. 25 crores in favour of SRPL at this stage.

5. The needful shall be done within one week.
