UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent-Institution, Roorkee. We have also perused the extract of the Minutes of the 10th Meeting of the Senate in the matter of transfer of a student from an Indian Institute of

Technology to any other Indian Institute of Technology.

2. In the instant case, it is noted that the petitioner cannot avail of his transfer to an Indian Institute Technology in Delhi on medical grounds owing to the difference in the curriculum B. Arch. Course. Therefore, learned senior counsel submitted that the petitioner may be transferred to the Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee. However, for that purpose, it is necessary that there should be a Medical Board constituted to examine the petitioner at the place from where the migration is not before recommending the migration.
3. Learned counsel for the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur submitted that they have no objection for the petitioner being transferred from Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur to any other institution.
4. In the circumstances, we direct the petitioner to appear before the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi (AIIMS) on 20.07.2026 so that the petitioner is evaluated medically and the report is submitted to this Court as we think it is not feasible in the circumstances to direct the petitioner to travel Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur for the aforesaid purpose.
5. The Director of AIIMS shall constitute a Medical Board which shall submit its report to this Court.

6. Since the last date for admission is stated to be on 17.07.2026, we direct IIT, Roorkee to keep one seat vacant subject to the result of this Writ Petition.
7. A copy of this order shall be sent by the Registry of this Court to the Director, AIIMS for compliance.
8. As requested, counter affidavit, if any, to be filed by Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee.
