**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
 O R D E R**

- 1. The delay of 77 days in filing the present miscellaneous application is condoned.**
- 2. The miscellaneous application is filed seeking clarification on the following two**

sentences contained in paragraph Nos. '9' and '10' of the order of this Court dated 02.02.2026:-

".....However, the respondent would be entitled to subsistence allowance from the date of his termination till the date of his actual retirement.

10. The inquiry, if initiated afresh, shall be completed within a period of three months' and the subsistence allowance be paid within two weeks'."

3. Mr. Rishabh Sancheti, learned counsel appearing for the applicant(s) argues that the direction to pay subsistence allowance through the order dated 02.02.2026 of this Court is unavailable inasmuch as the employee/respondent herein has received the salary after he has been reinstated. The direction now would virtually amount to additional or payment of ineligible allowance to the applicant(s).

4. Mr. Kaustubh Shukla, Advocate-on-record for the respondent herein does not seriously dispute the stand of the applicant.

5. We take note of the above submissions and modify the excerpted portion as follows:-

The inquiry initiated afresh shall be completed within a period of three months.

The corrected order copy is made available to the parties.

6. The copy of the corrected order is made

available to the parties.

7. The present miscellaneous application as well as IA No. 161350/2026 stand disposed of.
