O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Though pursuant to the Order dated 19.01.2026, this Court had

given time to the learned counsel for the petitioner to bring on record contemporaneous documents/evidence relating to the injuries suffered by the petitioner, but today, he submits that all the documents which were available to the petitioner are already on record.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.3-United India Insurance Company Limited submits that the disability certificate which is the centerpiece of the case of the petitioner is a document which does not inspire confidence.

4. As the issue basically relates to whether the petitioner has suffered a disability arising out of the accident and the percentage and nature of the same, with the consent of the parties, the matter is referred for re-evaluation by a duly constituted and competent medical board. The parties have agreed that the matter be referred to the Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences (for short, " PGIMS Rohtak")

5. Accordingly, a direction is issued to the Superintendent of PGIMS Rohtak to constitute a Medical Board, keeping in mind that the disability may relate to the locomotor system and the eyes. The parties are directed to appear before the Medical Superintendent, PGIMS Rohtak on 21.09.2026 at 11:00 AM. Thereafter, according to the instructions of the Medical Superintendent, the parties shall appear before the Medical Board so constituted. The Board shall submit a report within one month from the date on which the parties appear before the Board. The same shall be submitted to the Medical Superintendent, who in turn shall forward such report to this Court under sealed cover.

7. The parties shall cooperate with the Medical Board in the said examination/exercise.
