1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. The present Writ Petition has been filed by the Petitioner with the following prayer:

“In the premises aforesaid, it is most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to Issue Rule Nisi calling upon the Opposite Parties to show cause as to why the Environmental Clearance dated 25.11.2025 granted in favour of Opposite Party No. 6 under annexure-4 shall not be quashed and in case opp.parties do not show cause or shows insufficient this Hon'ble court may make the rule absolute by directing the Authorities as prayed above.

And pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

3. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

After advancing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has filed a representation dated 06.06.2026 vide Annexure-6 series, before the Opposite Party No.5/Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board (SPCB), Odisha, seeking redressal of his grievance. He further submits that the said representation is still pending for consideration.

In view of such facts and submission, without going into the merit of the case, the Opposite Party No.5/ Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board (SPCB), Odisha is directed to dispose of the representation of the Petitioner vide Annexure-6 series by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production/presentation of a certified copy of this order.
6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
