**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. The perusal of the case paper would disclose that in the writ petition that has been filed before the jurisdictional High Court, following two reliefs has been sought:

"a) A writ in the nature of certiorari and quash Exhibit-P2 Patta No.4354/1976 issued in O.A. No.8042/75 and Exhibit-P8 Patta No.6040/1976 issued in O.A. No.12224/75 on the file of the Deputy Collector (LR), Malappuram, after calling for records leading to them, declaring that the same is invalid, void, and non est and does not convey title as mentioned therein, being issued in violation of the provisions of the Kerala Land Reforms Act, Tenancy Rules and Vesting and Assignment Rules framed thereunder;

b) A writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the 3rd respondent to constitute a Special Investigation Team to probe into the scam/fraud encircling issuance of Exhibits-P2 and P8 Pattas and further illegalities brought to light in Exhibits-P6 and P7 Reports/proceedings of the Village Officer, Keezhuparambu, and Tahsildar, Ernad, Malappuram District and submit a report to this Hon'ble Court;"

2. The perusal of the impugned order would indicate that the High Court has proceeded to examine prayer (a) only and prayer (b) has been completely ignored. Hence, we issue notice, returnable in four weeks.
