O R D E R

1. Application for listing the review petition in open Court is rejected.

2. Delay condoned.

3. The Review Petition is listed before us with an office report on default dated 14.07.2026. The relevant portion of the office report is as follows:

“...However, the Review Petition is defective for the following reasons:

1. Incorrect Jurisdiction.

2. Deficit Court fees.

3. Preamble is missing in the petition...”

4. Despite this Registry's letter dated 07.05.2026 to the counsel for the petitioner to cure the defects, the defects have not been cured so far.

5. Even otherwise, perused the Review Petition. The main

ground for the review is that the Transfer Petition is allowed *ex-parte* without giving an opportunity to the petitioner.

6. We have considered the matter in detail. The order dated 18.02.2026 allowing the Transfer Petition was passed on the basis of an office report which clearly indicated that service of notice on sole respondent is complete. Despite completion of service the respondent has chosen not to represent himself before the Court.

7. The Transfer Petition seeks transfer of guardianship by Petition No. 118 of 2024 filed by the husband in Jodhpur. It is evident from record that the child, Ishika was living with her mother and in the natural course, a guardianship petition should have been filed at a place where the child is living. There is no dispute about the fact that child is living with the mother at Bijnor. Apart from that, there are other cases which are pending at Bijnor.

8. In view of the above, we are of the opinion that no case is made out for entertaining the review petition. The review petition is accordingly dismissed.
