1. Heard Mr.Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr.Panigrahy, learned counsel for the Bank-Opposite Parties.

Upon hearing both parties and considering the submissions made at the Bar, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Authorized Officer (Opposite Party No.1) to consider the grievance of the Petitioner for One Time Settlement as per his application at Annexure-4, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.1, no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner subject to deposit of Rs.10,00,000/-(Ten lakhs) within a period of thirty days from today.
