**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
 O R D E R**

1. The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of the High Court of Judicature at Bombay questioning a tender process on 2nd May, 2026.
2. According to the petitioner, the contract is yet to be awarded.
3. However, anxiety of the petitioner is that the award of the contract may be made any day and if so awarded, the writ petition which has been pending and not yet taken up for admission, would be rendered infructuous.
4. The order which is under challenge in this special leave petition records the inability of the Court to take up the writ petition for hearing due to paucity of time and directs re-listing on 20th July, 2026.

5. We appreciate the anxiety of the petitioner but at the same time it cannot be overlooked that the order under challenge is not an appealable order. In such view of the matter, no positive direction can be made.
6. We grant liberty to the petitioner to appear before the Court on 20th July, 2026 and request the roster Bench to consider its request for urgent intervention.
7. The special leave petition is disposed of on the above terms.
8. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
