			<u>CRLR/707/2026</u> Uttarakhand Transport Corporation --Revisionist Versus State Of Uttarakhand --Respondent <u>Hon'ble Alok Mahra, J.</u> Mr. Sachin Kumar Sharma, learned counsel for the revisionist through video conferencing. Mrs. Pushpa Bhatt, learned Additional Advocate General for the State of Uttarakhand. 2. The present Criminal Revision has been filed against the impugned judgment and order dated 17.08.2026, passed by the learned A.C.J.M., Roorkee, District Haridwar, in Case No. 1442 of 2021, "<i>State of Uttarakhand vs. Satish</i>", whereby the application moved by the revisionist seeking permission to auction the bus bearing registration No. UK-07PA-3145 was rejected. 3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that the aforesaid bus is no longer roadworthy and has completed its permissible period of operation on the road. It is submitted that the bus was manufactured in the year 2016 and, being a diesel vehicle, its prescribed life is ten years. It is, therefore, submitted that the revisionist moved an application seeking permission for auction of the said bus. 4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and upon perusal of the record, this Court finds that no fruitful purpose would be served by allowing the bus to remain parked and decay at the police station. Accordingly, permission is



			granted for auction of the aforesaid bus, subject to the following conditions: <i>(i) The bus shall be auctioned only to a registered scrap dealer;</i> <i>(ii) Photographs of the bus shall be taken and preserved before its auction; and</i> <i>(iii) The chassis number of the bus shall be duly recorded and preserved before handing over the vehicle to the scrap dealer.</i> 5. With the aforesaid directions, the present Criminal Revision stands disposed of. (Alok Mahra, J.) 15-09-2026 SB
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
