1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
 2. The petitioner in this writ petition prays for the following reliefs:-

“In view of the facts and circumstances stated above, the Petitioner respectfully prays that this Hon’ble Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Opposite Parties to postpone the E-Auction for Sale to future date or to give few more days to repay the entire amount in dues as the Petitioner has already paid more than half of the Loan amount.”
 3. Mr. Sahu, learned counsel for the Union Bank of India submits that e-auction was held on 28th July, 2026 and has failed.
 4. Hence, Mr. Sahoo, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing remains to be adjudicated in the writ petition as it has become infructuous.
