O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-original plaintiff vehemently submitted that the defendant nos.1 and 2 respectively ought not to have been permitted to file additional documents more particularly, when the oral evidence of the defendant nos.3 and 4 is also closed. He would argue that had these documents being produced along with the written statement, he would

have led the evidence in a particular manner. Since the Courts below have permitted the defendant nos.1 and 2 respectively to adduce additional documents, it shall be open for the petitioner to deal with those documents at the time of cross-examination of defendant nos.1 and 2 respectively. It shall also be open for the petitioner to make a request to the Court below to recall his witnesses so as to meet with the additional documents which the Courts below have permitted the defendant nos.1 and 2 respectively to bring on record.
