UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Having regard to the decision of this Court in ***Kangra Central Cooperative Bank Limited v. Kangra Central Cooperative Bank Pensioners Welfare Association (Regd.) and Ors.***¹ as well as the several decisions referred to therein, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment(s) and order(s) of the High Court; hence, the special leave petitions stand dismissed.
2. Mr. Rana Mukherjee, learned senior counsel has submitted that platform nos.4 and 5 of Lumding station, under N. F. Railway have been vacated by the members of the petitioning Association.
3. If indeed that be so, no further order is required for displacing them. However, in the event the respondents find that platform nos.4 and 5 have not been vacated, either fully or in part, we allow the respondents to take such action as to ensure that the platforms are made free from obstruction for continuing the developmental work.
4. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
