Dhyani, learned counsel for the petitioner is connected virtually. 2. Mr. Ashish Joshi, learned counsel for the respondent-SBI. 3. Petitioner has challenged the demand notice, which is impugned in this writ petition, which is enclosed as Annexure 1 to the supplementary affidavit. The same was issued under Section 13(2) of the SARFAESI Act, 2002. 4. Learned counsel appearing for the Bank submits that against notice issued under Section 13(2) of the SARFAESI Act, petitioner has remedy of making representation under Section 13(3A) of the Act. 5. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with liberty to petitioner to make representation against the impugned notice dated 24.07.2026. Petitioner shall also be at liberty to make representation, for enforcement of

If petitioner makes representation, against the notice under Section 13(2) of the Act, within four days from today, the same shall be decided by the Competent Authority within two weeks. Petitioner shall also be at liberty to make separate representation, regarding enforcement of Guidelines issued by Reserve Bank of India, within ten days.
