# Alloy-wrecking potholes on Delhi-Dehradun away after first rain of season

Dehradun/Shamli: A newly built Rs 12,000-cr expressway. One spell of rain. Then came potholes big enough to wreck alloys and topple vehicles.

The 212-km Delhi-Dehradun Expressway, hailed as a flagship project, has come under scrutiny after two large potholes appeared on the stretch in UP's Shamli following the season's first significant rainfall. "We were fortunate that our vehicle didn't overturn. They were almost 1.5 feet deep and around 3.5 feet wide", said Mohammad Usman, a Delhi cloth merchant, who was travelling to Mussoorie with family on Wednesday when his vehicle struck one of the potholes.

Repair crews from NHAJ were deployed to fill the potholes and restore the affected stretch

Usman told TOI that several vehicles narrowly escaped accidents while trying to swerve to avoid it.

In a video recorded shortly after the discovery, he can be heard saying that four to five vehicles lost their balance while passing through the damaged stretch. He also claimed that "at least two cars suffered bent alloy wheels". Shaken, Usman and his

family stopped along the roadside to warn other motorists before filming the damaged section and posting it on Instagram. The video drew widespread attention and concern over the "quality of construction work".

NHAJ soon deployed repair crews. Sonu Balyan, the driver of a patrol vehicle accompanying the maintenance team, attributed the damage to intense overnight rainfall. "The potholes have now been repaired," he said.

NHAJ has issued show-cause notices to the contractor and the independent engineer for alleged negligence in supervision. Officials said that the project director has also been told to fix responsibility for the "lapse". The prompt repair, however, has done little to ease concerns among the road users, particularly night travellers. "I was travelling from Delhi to Dehradun Wednesday when I spotted these large potholes. Luckily, my vehicle missed them as I was driving in another lane, but they looked dangerous," Mudit Agarwal, a businessman, wrote on a social media platform.

## NHAJ cracks down on Doon way project head, contractor & engg

New Delhi: NHAJ has issued show-cause notices to its project director, a contractor and authority engineer after a video of a section of the Delhi-Dehradun Expressway caving in went viral. It said the incident was caused due to "water accumulation" as the permanent cross-drainage system at the site could not be constructed due to sustained resistance from locals.

Officials said the project director has been instructed to fix responsibility for the incident and the authority engineer (AE) has been asked to explain negligence in services. "The team leader of AE (consulting firm) has been suspended. The highway contractor has been asked to explain why it should not be declared a non-performer and debarred from NHAJ's future projects. The contractor's project manager has been suspended as well," said an official.

On X, NHAJ regretted the inconvenience caused to commuters due to the incident following rainfall.

# Pharma pricing norms for new drugs eased

## Compliance Rules Also Get Relaxations

New Delhi: In the biggest overhaul of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order (DPCO), 2013 in years, Centre has significantly narrowed drug-makers' liability in overcharging cases, while introducing a host of long-pending changes sought by the pharma industry. The amendments, notified on June 30 and effective immediately, ease compliance for pharma companies, simplify pricing approvals for certain new drug launches, strengthen record-keeping requirements and clarify overcharging rules, sources told TOI.

"These provisions are in line with govt's objective of improving ease of doing business while preserving the integrity of the drug price control framework. They bring much-needed clarity on several operational issues, particularly around pricing, overcharging and compliance, which have been the subject of differing interpretations since DPCO, 2013 came into force," Sudarshan Jain, secretary general, Indian Pharmaceutical Alliance, told TOI.

# Puri: 'Minor' cut in mileage of E20 vehicles inevitable

New Delhi: Seeking to allay public fears over ethanol-blended fuel, petroleum minister Hardeep Singh Puri Thursday said a "make-believe" narrative had been unleashed on social media over the past few days, reports Atul Mathur.

Addressing a press conference, the minister said the reduction in mileage of an E20-fuelled vehicle is "minor". "It is well established that when you have ethanol in a vehicle, which they use in racing cars also, the acceleration increases, knocking improves. Mileage may drop a little, but it can happen because of many other reasons also," he said. Puri added that insurance companies had also issued clarifications regarding vehicle coverage. Puri said his ministry had compiled a 15-page note tracing the journey of ethanol blending, listing the countries where it is practised. The note will also answer people's concerns.

The note stated that "misleading videos, selectively edited clips and sensational social media posts" were being circulated with the objective of "creating fear amongst vehicle owners" regarding the use of E20 fuel.

Puri said India adopted 20% ethanol blending in petrol after consulting all stakeholders, including SIAM and ARAI, and would move to 25% blending only after completing all necessary tests. The minister said the concept of ethanol blending was not new and prominent car maker Henry Ford called it the "fuel of the future".

## Def ministry may clear proposals worth over ₹ 1L cr today

New Delhi: The defence ministry is expected to clear on Friday several proposals, estimated to be worth over Rs 1 lakh crore, including the acquisition of K-9 Vajra self-propelled howitzers, HAMMER air-to-ground precision guided munitions, a large number of Russian-origin Verba very short-range air defence systems, man portable anti-tank guided missiles, fixed-wing pseudo satellites and naval shipborne aerial systems, reports Surendra Singh.

The acquisition proposals are expected to be taken up for clearance by Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), which will see newly appointed Chief of Defence Staff Gen Raja Subramani, Army chief Gen Dhiraj Seth and Admiral Krishna Swaminathan attending the key meeting as chiefs for the first time.

"The Scorpene submarine deal may not come up for clearance this time," a source told TOI.

Army is planning its largest artillery expansion by procuring 300 additional K-9 Vajra 155mm/52-calibre tracked self-propelled howitzers. Like the earlier lot, the new howitzers will be built locally by L&T in technological partnership with South Korea's Hanwha Aerospace. Army is also likely to get 100 launchers along with 2,300 missiles and five simulators for the weapon system.

## After WA, govt sends notices to Telegram, Signal

New Delhi: A day after directing Meta to pause WhatsApp's proposed username feature, govt has issued similar notices to Telegram and Signal over their existing username systems, asking them to explain how they prevent fraud and impersonation.

The IT ministry wants detailed responses on safeguards against scams, phishing, digital art frauds and identity impersonation. Like WhatsApp, Telegram and Signal have been given three days to respond, sources said. In Telegram's case, govt has also asked why the platform should be allowed to continue offering the username feature. The notices come a day after the Centre wrote to Meta, expressing concern that WhatsApp's proposed username feature could increase cybercrime by making it easier for bad actors to contact users without sharing phone numbers. TNN

**NHAI cracks down on Doon way project head, contractor & engineer**

New Delhi: NHAI has issued show-cause notices to its project director, a contractor and authority engineer after a video of a section of the Delhi-Dehradun Expressway caving in went viral. It said the incident was caused due to "water accumulation" as the permanent cross-drainage system at the site could not be constructed due to sustained resistance from locals.

Officials said the project director has been instructed to fix responsibility for the incident and the authority engineer (AE) has been asked to explain negligence in services. "The team leader of AE (consulting firm) has been suspended. The highway contractor has been asked to explain why it should not be declared a non-performer and debarred from NHAI's future projects. The contractor's project manager has been suspended as well," said an official.

On X, NHAI regretted the inconvenience caused to commuters due to the incident following rainfall.

**Alloy-wrecking potholes on Delhi-Doon way after first rain of season**

**Dehradun/Shamli:** A newly built Rs 12,000-crore expressway: One spell of rain. Then came potholes big enough to wreck alloys and topple vehicles.

The 212-km Delhi-Dehradun Expressway, hailed as a flagship project, has come under scrutiny after two large potholes appeared on the stretch in UP's Shamli following the season's first significant rainfall. "We were fortunate that our vehicle didn't overturn. They were almost 1.5 feet deep and around 3.5 feet wide," said Mohammad Usman, a Delhi cloth merchant, who was travelling to Mussoorie with family on Wednesday when his vehicle struck one of the potholes.

Usman told TOI that several vehicles narrowly escaped accidents while trying to swerve to avoid it them.

In a video recorded shortly after

the discovery, he can be heard saying that four to five vehicles lost their balance while passing through the damaged stretch. He also claimed that "at least two cars suffered bent alloy wheels".

Shaken, Usman and his family stopped along the roadside to warn other motorists before filming the damaged section and posting it on Instagram. The video drew widespread attention and concern over

"the quality of construction work". NHAI soon deployed repair crews. Sonu Balyian, the driver of a patrol vehicle accompanying the maintenance team, attributed the damage to intense overnight rainfall. "The potholes have now been repaired," Balyian said.

NHAI has issued show-cause notices to the road contractor and the independent engineer for alleged negligence in supervision. Officials said that the project director has also been told to fix responsibility for the "lapse".

The prompt repair, however, has done little to ease concerns among the road users, particularly night travellers. "I was travelling from Delhi to Dehradun on Wednesday when I spotted these large potholes. Luckily, my vehicle missed them as I was driving in another lane, but they looked dangerous," Mudit Agarwal, a businessman, wrote on a social media platform.

**Puri: 'Minor' cut in mileage of E20 vehicles inevitable**

**New Delhi:** Seeking to allay public fears over ethanol-blended fuel, petroleum minister Hardeep Singh Puri Thursday said a "make-believe" narrative had been unleashed on social media over the past few days, reports **Atul Mathur**.

Addressing a press conference, the minister said the reduction in mileage of an E20-fuelled vehicle is "minor". "It is well established that when you have ethanol in a vehicle, which they use in racing cars also, the acceleration increases, knocking improves. Mileage may drop a little, but it can happen because of many other reasons also," he said.

Puri said that insurance companies had also issued clarifications regarding vehicle coverage. Puri said his ministry had compiled a 15-page note tracing the journey of ethanol blending, listing the countries where it is practised. The note will also answer people's concerns.

The note stated that "misleading videos, selectively edited clips and sensational social media posts" were being circulated with the objective of "creating fear amongst vehicle owners" regarding the use of E20 fuel.

Puri said India adopted 20% ethanol blending in petrol after consulting all stakeholders, including SIAM and ARAI, and would move to 25% blending only after completing all necessary tests. The minister said the concept of ethanol blending was not new and prominent car maker Henry Ford called it the "fuel of the future".
