O R D E R

1. We do not find any good ground to entertain this petition. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
2. Shri V Giri, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) submits that the Bank would work out a Scheme for the payments of the amount as ordered by the High Court. In the event

of such a prayer being made in the contempt proceedings, which is pending, the same shall be considered by the jurisdictional High Court sympathetically and the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to work out its Scheme in accordance with law subject to the respondent(s) also being heard in the matter before such Scheme being formulated. The said exercise shall be undertaken by petitioner expeditiously at any rate within an outer limit of three months from today.
