UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have perused the Report dated 07.01.2009 of the Medical Board- Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh (PGIMER) which was submitted before the High Court

of Punjab and Haryana (Page 207). The High Court proceeded on the premise and observed that "claimant (respondent No.1 herein) has lost hearing in both his ears and is suffering from tinnitus in brain and both inner ears, vertigo, headache, insomnia and depression, diabetes, etc. causing adverse effect on the health of the claimant."

2. Before we proceed to hear the matter on merits, we are of the considered view that respondent No.1 be re-examined by the Medical Board to be constituted by the Director of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi.

3. We request the Director, AIIMS to constitute a Medical Board to examine respondent No.1 regarding the alleged ailment which he is suffering from and the possible treatment which can be admissible to him either in India or Abroad. The Report of the Board be submitted within next six weeks.

4. The Registry shall forward a copy of the order to the Director, AIIMS, Delhi.

5. Mr. Neeraj Kishan Kaul, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, under instructions, submits that all travelling expenses and medical expenses for undertaking such process, shall be borne by the petitioner.

6. The learned counsel for the respondent(s) make available entire medical record to the Board.

7. We request the parties to co-ordinate with the Director-AIIMS.
