A W A R D

1. This Civil Appeal is pending since long. The insurance claim of Rs. 16.6 Lakhs was considered by the District Consumer Redressal Forum and an amount of Rs. 12.45 Lakhs was granted to the claimant. The State Commission allowed the respondent's appeal and the National Commission affirmed the same vide impugned order dated 21.11.2016.

2. We have heard Mr. Ravi Kumar Tomar, learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Rajeev M. Roy, learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

3. We are happy to note that the parties have settled the matter finally with the Insurance Company agreeing to pay an amount of Rs.23,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs) as full and final

settlement of all claims of the appellant.

4. We record the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and dispose of the civil appeal in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties. The said amount shall be paid by the Insurance Company within a period of 45 days from today.
