UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. We see no reason to entertain the special leave petition. Hence, the special leave petition stands dismissed.

3. After the order is dictated, Mr. Pradhuman Gohil, appearing for the petitioner, requests the Court to grant reasonable time to vacate /remove the storage facilities/equipment, fixtures, fittings, and hand over vacant possession to the landlord/DHR.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent, firstly, opposed granting any time. Secondly, states that a reasonable period of one month can be considered and granted subject to the petitioner-firm together with the partners filing an undertaking before this Court to this effect on or before 14.09.2026.

5. We take note of the submissions and the long pending litigation between the parties. With a view to facilitating the petitioner for removing the storage facilities/equipment, fixtures, fittings from the site, a month's time from today is granted, subject to an affidavit undertaking filed by the petitioner and the partners of the firm, in this Court, on or before 14.09.2026 and will continue to pay the agreed rent between the parties till the petitioner vacates the premises.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
