O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. CBI is aggrieved by the order dated 18th February, 2026 passed by the High Court of Jharkhand by which the High Court rejected the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition preferred by the CBI and, thereby, affirmed the order passed by the

AJC-XVIII-cum-Special Judge, CBI, Ranchi, allowing a petition preferred by the respondent-accused under Section 91 of the Cr.P.C. seeking direction for supply of few documents.

3. We heard Mr. S.V. Raju, the learned ASG assisted by Mr. A. Venkatesh, the learned counsel appearing for the CBI.

4. Two-fold submissions have been put forward before us. First, the source of information received by the CBI can never be disclosed to the accused and, secondly, the case diaries cannot be provided to the accused.

5. The learned ASG would submit that at the most, the case diaries could be put forward before the Trial Court for its perusal.

6. On the aforesaid two counts, we are inclined to issue notice.

7. Issue notice, returnable in the next week.

8. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.

9. In the meantime, there shall be stay of operation of the impugned order passed by the High Court.
