O R D E R

1. Interest has been paid @ 6% per annum. However, in our view, in the facts and circumstances of this case, lump sum amount of interest Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs only), if paid, the

controversy may be put to a quietus. We make it clear that this decision would not have any adverse effect on the pending civil suit, if any,. The interest be paid within a period of eight weeks. The amount of litigation expenses lying in the FDR be paid to the respondent on furnishing Bank Account details.

2. Accordingly, the special leave petition is disposed of. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
