**IA (IBC)/219/2026:**

Mr. Kallam Nagi Reddy, Respondent No. 2, appeared in person and sought two weeks' time to engage a Counsel and file his counter. Time, as prayed for, is granted.

The Registry is directed to issue notices to Respondent Nos. 1 and 3 to 22, informing them of the next date of hearing, and to place on record proof of service thereof. Upon receipt of such notice, Respondent Nos. 1 and 3 to 22 are granted two weeks' time to file their vakalatnama through

Counsel and their respective counters, after duly serving copies upon the opposite side. List the matter on 29.06.2026 for further consideration.

**IA (IBC)/187/2026:**

This application has been filed by the Resolution Professional (RP) under Section 12(2) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 read with Regulation 40 of the IBBI (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) Regulations, 2016, seeking extension of the CIRP period by a further 60 days beyond 05.05.2026.

Today, the Counsel for the RP, along with the RP, appeared and submitted that the Committee of Creditors (CoC), in its 6th meeting held on 31.03.2026, with 93.1% voting share, resolved to authorize the RP to file the present application seeking extension of the CIRP period by a further period of 60 days. Considering the submissions made and the resolution passed by the CoC, the CIRP period is extended by a further period of 60 days commencing from 05.05.2026. **Accordingly, IA(IBC)/187/2026 stands allowed and disposed of.**
