Cooker lid flung during dispute kills infant

Man tries to attack his daughter, misses target and hits the nine-month-old baby in her arms instead; arrested

A nine-month-old infant died near Kumarapalayam in Namakkal after being accidentally hit by a cooking vessel lid during a domestic dispute involving the child's maternal grandfather.

Police identified the accused as Venkatachalam (41), a resi-

dent of Veppankadu Moodamangalam village near Vepadai in Kumarapalayam. Police sources said, Venkatachalam's daughter, V. Monisha (20), had entered into an inter-caste marriage with Mayilandantham (24) of Bhavani around two years ago, and the couple later had a nine-month-old son, M. Joswik.

Police said Venkatachalam strongly opposed his daughter's

marriage from the beginning and had reportedly severed ties with her following her marriage. However, after the birth of the child, Monisha, on the insistence of her mother, had been visiting her parental home frequently in an attempt to maintain family ties. Despite this, tensions between the father and daughter reportedly continued, with repeated verbal altercations break-

ing out whenever she visited, sources added.

On Wednesday, another argument allegedly broke out between Venkatachalam and Monisha, which escalated into a heated exchange. In a fit of anger, Venkatachalam allegedly threw a cooker lid towards his daughter, who was holding the infant in her hands at the time, but it accidentally struck the

baby, causing the child to collapse and faint immediately.

Monisha and her mother rushed the infant to a nearby primary health centre, where doctors, after examination, declared that the baby had already died before reaching the centre. Following the incident, Vepadai police registered a murder case against Venkatachalam and arrested him.

MANHUNT ON FOR 75-YEAR-OLD CONMAN IN KOVAI

A neatly pressed white dhoti and shirt, a soft-spoken demeanor and the promise of a central government pension for the elderly: No, these are not the characteristics of your average senior citizen next door. It is how the police describe a 75-year-old conman who has been terrorising elderly women in Coimbatore city for over a year. His modus operandi is simple and straightforward — approach the victim and strike up a conversation that goes, "The central government provides a monthly old-age pension to seniors like us, and I just received mine. I can arrange for you to receive it."

He then lures the victim and flees with their jewellery.

The suspect, who has consistently managed to evade capture, struck again a few days ago in Ramanathapuram area. Spinning the same fabricated story, he gained the trust of a 70-year-old woman and fled with her of her gold earrings.

The victim, Kasturi (70), wife of Kasiappan from Krishnan Kollai Street in Ramanathapuram, was staying at the Ramanathapuram junction two days ago when the suspect approached her on a two-wheeler. He told her he could help her get a monthly pension of ₹3,000 under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Old-Age Pension Scheme. He established his credibility by claiming that he too was a beneficiary.

Convinced, Kasturi agreed to accompany him. He then had her board his motorcycle, promising to take her to the relevant government office. Upon reaching near Iyer Hospital bus stop, the elderly man stopped his bike. He then instructed Kasturi to remove and hand over the earrings and nose rings she was wearing, saying the officials would not disburse the old-age pension if she was found wearing jewellery. The suspect claimed he would keep the jewellery safe, told her he was going to a photocopy shop to make a copy of an application form for an old-age pension, and then fled the scene. Kasturi waited for a long time, before she realised she had been cheated.

A theft case was registered on Wednesday. The jewellery he stole is estimated to be worth around ₹20,000. Police said similar cases were registered at the Bazaar Station and Variety Hall Road Police Stations about a year ago. "We have almost confirmed that the same person is consistently involved in such incidents," said an officer.

An investigation into the vehicle registration number revealed that it belongs to a resident of Selvapuram. However, the owner's father, Amanullah, had reportedly taken the vehicle and gone into hiding a few months ago. "It remains unclear whether the person committing these crimes is the man who went missing," the police added.

Insurer told to pay ₹5L to jallikattu victim's kin

THE Madurai Bench of Madras High Court recently directed an insurance company to pay ₹5 lakh to a woman whose husband was gored to death by a bull during a jallikattu event in Eratchandrar Thirumalai village in Karur in 2025.

Justice D Bharatha Chakravarthy passed the order on a petition filed by the woman, K. Mathuram, seeking direction to the company to disburse the amount.

According to Mathuram, her husband, a retired school teacher, had gone to watch the jallikattu event in the above village in the Kullithalai taluk of Karur last January. When he was standing near the collection point, a bull that participated in the event gored him to death.

A case was registered in this regard by the Thogamalai police. Though the event was fully insured so that in case of any untoward incidents, ₹5 lakh may be paid to the victim's fam-

ily, she has not received any payment so far.

But the counsel representing the insurance company raised two objections. He said the victim was standing near the collection point and not the spectator gallery, and the name of the bull owner was not mentioned in the FIR, making it impossible to verify if the death had indeed occurred due to a bull that participated in the jallikattu.

Upon hearing the plea, the judge criticised the event organiser for failing to respond to the court despite notice. He directed the Karur collector not to permit him to conduct jallikattu events in the future. As regards the company's objections, the judge pointed out that the FIR does not say that the victim led the public gallery and went near the collection point.

The gallery extended from Vadivallu to the collection point, and the victim could have stood in the gallery, which was close to the collection point, the judge noted.

RAMANATHAPURAM: Two construction workers were fatally knocked down by a car, which reportedly was driven by a drunk driver, near a construction site in Sanyakudi-Anupukketal Road in Ramanathapuram district on Thursday. The deceased were P. Vanchinaran (45) and G. Jayaman (55) from K. Karisalkulam. The accident happened when the duo were working near the site when a car driven by R. Illavarasan (42) from Abramam hit the workers. Illavarasan was caught by the public and later handed over to the Sanyakudi police. The police said the driver was also injured in the accident. Two leopards found dead in Anamalai Tiger Reserve

TWO leopards, including a one-and-a-half-year-old female, were found dead in separate incidents in the Anamalai Tiger Reserve (ATR) and the Gudalur Forest Division in the Nilgiris district.

In the first incident, a postmortem on Thursday revealed that the young leopardess died while attempting to hunt prey in Meenpara forest area of Manobolli Forest Range near Valparai.

"We noticed injury marks on the carcass, allegedly caused by the horns of a sambar or spotted deer. As the animal was young and had likely just begun hunting, it appears to have been fatally injured by the antlers. The injuries may have prevented it from feeding and also caused severe pain," said Manobolli Forest Range

Field staff discovered the carcass on Wednesday evening, and the postmortem was carried out

by veterinarians T. Meyyarasan and Dharmaraj, in the presence of representatives from NGOs, including NCF and WVE. The carcass was later cremated as per NTCA guidelines.

In the second incident, a seven-year-old male leopard was found dead on Section 17 land at Silver Cloud Estate in the Gudalur Forest Range.

"There were no external injuries on the animal, ruling out death due to fighting or electrocution. We suspect natural causes since there was no prey in its stomach.

Samples of internal organs have been collected and sent for analysis to determine the exact cause of death," said Forest Range Officer C. Veeramani.

The official added that the carcass was found about 300 metres from the forest boundary. Estate workers first noticed the animal and alerted forest officials. The area is known to be frequented by leopards.

TN minister admits father in govt hospital

Minister C. K. Jayaprakash Reddy admitted his father P. Perumal in the Kovilpatti government hospital (GH) after he fell ill.

Sources said the minister's father suffered age-related issues and was first taken to the Kovilpatti GH on Wednesday night. As per doctors' advice, he was shifted to the Tirunelveli medical college hospital on Thursday morning. TvMCH Dean Dr. Revathi Balan told TNIE that Perumal has been admitted in the super speciality block and is responding to treatment. The minister stayed in the hospital overnight. It may be recalled that Health Minister Dr. KG Arunraj had appealed to government servants, including ministers, to get treated in government facilities. ENS
