O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Issue notice.

3. Mr. Apoorv Agarwal, learned counsel appearing for the respondent/caveator, accepts notice.
4. Petitioner shall deposit with the Registry Rs.43,20,00,000/- (Rupees forty-three crore twenty lakhs) only together with 15% interest as directed by the High Court within a period of two months from date.
5. Once the deposit is made, the Registry shall invest the said amount in a short-term interest bearing fixed deposit account of a nationalized Bank on auto renewal basis.
6. In the event the deposit is not made within the stipulated period, the special leave petitions shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.
7. We record the submission of Mr. Jaideep Gupta, learned senior counsel that the petition for contempt shall not be pressed till such time the special leave petitions are considered next.
8. Relist the special leave petitions on 01st December, 2026.
9. Counter affidavit be filed within six weeks; rejoinder thereto, if any. May be filed by two weeks thereafter.
