1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents for cancellation and re-conducting of examination held on 21.02.2026 to 01.03.2026 for the posts of Group A, Group B and Group C.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the order dated 20.03.2026 passed by this Court in the earlier petition filed by the petitioners bearing *CWP No.8576 of 2026 (Maninder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others)*, respondent No.4-Managing Director, Sugarfed, Punjab has passed the speaking order dated 29.05.2026, whereby a representation dated 09.03.2026 submitted by the petitioner before the respondents has been disposed of and the said order has not been challenged in the instant petition.

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3. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by impugning the order dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure R-1) passed by respondent No.4.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

5. Pending application, if any, shall stands disposed of accordingly.
