1. ISSUE OF WARRANTS, CONVERTIBLE INTO EQUITY SHARES TO PERSON(S) BELONGING TO THE NON-PROMOTER/PUBLIC CATEGORY ON PREFERENTIAL BASIS.

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without modification(s), the following resolution as a Special Resolution:

“**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23, 42 and 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014 and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory amendment(s) or modification(s) thereto or enactment(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) (the “Act”); and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended from time to time (“ICDR Regulations” or “SEBI ICDR Regulations”); and any other rules/ regulations/ guidelines, if any, prescribed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (“SEBI”), Reserve Bank of India (“RBI”), Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, as amended, the Foreign Exchange Management (Transfer or Issue of Security by a Person Resident Outside India) Regulations, 2000, as amended, and the rules, regulations, guidelines, notifications and circulars, if any, issued by the Government of India, Stock Exchanges where the equity shares of the Company are listed (“Stock Exchanges”) and/ or any other statutory/ regulatory authority; and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended from time to time (“Listing Regulations”); and the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company; and subject to the approval(s), consent(s), permission(s) and/ or sanction(s), if any, of the appropriate authorities, institutions or bodies as may be required, and subject to such conditions and modifications, as may be prescribed by any of them while granting any such approval(s), consent(s), permission(s), and/ or sanction(s), and which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the “Board” which term shall be deemed to include any Committee which the Board may have constituted, or hereinafter constitute to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution), the Consent of the Members of the Company, be and is hereby accorded to create, offer, issue and allot, on preferential basis, in one or more tranches, up to maximum of 66,00,000 (Sixty-six Lakhs Only) warrants, each convertible into, 1 (one) fully paid-up equity share of the Company having face value of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five Only) (“Equity Share”) each (“Warrants”) at a price (including the Warrant Subscription Price and the Warrant Exercise Price) of Rs. 117.50/- (Rupees One Hundred and Seventeen and Fifty Paise only) each payable in cash (“Warrant

Issue Price”), aggregating up to Rs. 77,55,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy-seven Crores Fifty-five Lakhs Only) (“**Total Issue Size**”) on a preferential basis to non-promoter/public category listed below (“Warrant Holder(s)” / “Proposed Allottee(s)”) subject to the maximum entitlement of each Warrant Holder as specified below and upon receipt of Rs. 29.38 (Rupees Twenty-nine and Thirty-eight paise Only) for each Warrants, which is equivalent to 25% (twenty-five per cent) of the Warrant Issue Price as upfront payment (“Warrant Subscription Price”) entitling the Warrant Holder(s) to apply for and get allotted one fully paid-up equity share of the Company of face value of Rs. 5/- each against every Warrant held, in one or more tranches within a maximum period of 18 (eighteen) months from the date of allotment of Warrants, on payment of Rs. 88.12 /- (Rupees Eighty-eight and Twelve Paise only) which is equivalent to 75% (Seventy-five per cent) of the Warrant Issue Price, for each Warrant proposed to be converted, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by the Board in accordance with the terms of this issue, provisions of ICDR Regulations, or other applicable laws in this respect:

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the offer, issue and allotment of the aforesaid Warrants to the Proposed Allottees and the Equity Shares resulting from the exercise of the entitlement of the said warrants, shall be subject to applicable guidelines, notifications, rules and regulations and on the terms and conditions given herein below:

a) The “**Relevant Date**” pursuant to Regulation 161 of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations in relation to the above-mentioned Preferential Issue of Warrants is **Friday, 11th September, 2026**, being the date, which is 30 days prior to the date on which the resolution will be deemed to be passed i.e. **Wednesday, 14th October, 2026**.

b) Amount payable on Allotment of Warrants shall be 25% of the price per warrant and amount payable before the date of conversion of Warrants into equity shares would be 75% of the total consideration.

c) The said Warrant(s) shall be issued and allotted to the Proposed Allottees within a period of 15 days from the date of passing of this resolution, in dematerialized form provided that in case the allotment of the said Warrants is pending on account of pendency of any approval or permission by any regulatory authority or the Government of India, the allotment shall be completed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of last such approval or permissions.

d) The equity shares allotted on conversion of the warrants shall rank pari -passu in all respects (including voting powers and the right to receive dividend), with the existing equity shares of the Company from the date of allotment thereof and shall be subject to the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.

e) The tenure of warrants shall not exceed 18 (eighteen) months from the date of allotment of the warrants.

f) The proposed allottee(s) of Warrants shall be entitled to exercise option to convert warrants, in one or more tranches for allotment of one Equity Share of face value of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five only) for every

warrant, within a period of 18 (eighteen) months from the date of allotment of such warrants and upon exercise of the option by Proposed Allottees, the company shall issue and allot appropriate number of Equity Shares and perform all such actions as are required including to credit the same to the designated securities demat account of the Proposed Allottees.

g) In case the Warrant holder does not apply for the conversion of the outstanding warrants into equity shares of the company within 18 (eighteen) months from the date of allotment of the said warrants, then the amount paid on each of the said outstanding warrants shall be forfeited and all the rights attached to the said warrants shall lapse automatically.

h) The said warrants by itself, until exercise of conversion option into equity shares allotted, does not give to the warrant holder any rights with respect to that of the shareholders of the company.

i) The warrants shall be exercised in a manner that is in compliance with the minimum public shareholding norms prescribed for the Company under the LODR Regulations and the Securities Contracts (Regulation) Rules, 1957.

j) The issue of the warrants as well as equity shares arising from the exercise of the warrants shall be governed by the regulations and guidelines issued by SEBI or any other statutory authority as the case may be including any modifications thereof from time to time.

k) Upon exercise of the option by the allottee to convert the warrants into the equity shares within a period of 18 months, the equity shares, pursuant to exercise of warrants, shall be allotted within a period of 15 days from the date of such exercise by the allottee in compliance with provisions of Regulation 162(2) of ICDR Regulations.

l) The Warrants and the equity shares allotted pursuant to exercise of such warrants shall be subject to a lock-in for such period as specified under applicable provisions of the ICDR Regulations and allotted equity shares shall be listed on the stock exchanges where the equity shares of the Company are listed, subject to the receipt of necessary permissions and approvals. Further, the aforesaid warrants shall not be sold, transferred, hypothecated or encumbered in any manner by the Proposed Allottees during the period of lock-in, except to the extent and in the manner permitted under SEBI ICDR Regulations.

m) The Company shall procure the listing and trading approvals for the equity shares to be issued and allotted to the warrant holders upon exercise of the warrants from the relevant stock exchanges in accordance with the LODR Regulations and all other applicable laws, rules and regulation.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to issue and allot such equity shares as may be required to be issued and allotted upon conversion of the said warrants and that equity shares shall be subject to the provisions of the Articles of Association of the company and shall rank pari-passu in all respects, including entitlement for dividend, with the existing equity shares of the company.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to decide and approve other terms and conditions of the issue of the warrants and/ or equity shares and shall also be entitled to vary, modify or alter any of the terms and conditions, as it may deem fit, subject however to the compliance with the applicable guidelines, notifications, rules and regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to, do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may in its absolute discretion deem necessary or desirable to give effect to the above resolution, including without limitation issuing clarifications on the issue and allotment of Warrants, resolving any difficulties, effecting any modifications to the foregoing (including any modifications to the terms of the issue) preparing, signing and filing applications with the appropriate authorities for obtaining requisite approvals, including making application to Stock Exchange for obtaining of in-principle approval, listing of shares pursuant to conversion of warrants, filing of requisite documents with the Registrar of Companies, National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL), Central

Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), and/or such other authorities as may be necessary for the purpose, to appoint such consultants, legal advisors and all such agencies as may be required for issuance of the Warrants, and to delegate all or any of the powers conferred by the aforesaid resolutions on it to any committee of Directors or any Director(s) or officer(s) of the Company and to revoke and substitute such delegation from time to time, as deemed fit by the Board, to give effect to the above resolutions and also to initiate all necessary actions for and to settle all questions, difficulties or doubts whatsoever that may arise and take all steps and decisions in this regard and all actions taken by the Board in connection with any matter(s) referred to or contemplated in any of the foregoing resolutions be and are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed in all respects.

In view of COVID-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') vide General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and Circular No. 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022, Circular no. 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022, Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023, Circular No. 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024, and Circular No. 03/2025 dated September 22, 2025, (collectively the '**MCA Circulars**') and Securities Exchange Board of India vide SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May 12, 2020, Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 dated January 15, 2021 and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022, SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 5, 2023 and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/167 dated October 7, 2023, (collectively referred as 'SEBI Circular') (MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular collectively referred as 'Circulars') permitted holding of General Meetings through VC/OAVM and have dispensed the physical presence of the members at the meeting. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations'), and MCA Circulars, the present meeting is proposed to be convened through VC/OAVM. The facility of remote e-voting will be available during the prescribed time period before the meeting and through e-voting platform available during the meeting. In compliance with the General Circular No. 20/2020 issued by the MCA, item mentioned in special business in this EGM Notice are considered unavoidable and forms part of this Notice.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended), the company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") to provide remote e-voting facility before the meeting; and to provide e-voting platform during the meeting, in a secured manner. M/s **MAS Services Limited**, a SEBI registered Registrar and Transfer Agent (RTA) is appointed to provide a platform for convening the meeting through Video Conferencing; to handle and supervise the entire process of holding the meeting through Video Conferencing, e-voting, and processing of data relating to the meeting and voting, etc.
3. Notice of the meeting is being sent to all such equity shareholders who hold shares as on the cut-off date **i.e. Friday, 18th September, 2026**.
4. In compliance with the aforesaid circulars, the Notice of the EGM is being sent to the Members and all other persons so entitled in electronic mode only, whose email addresses are registered with the Company/Depositories. Members whose email address is not registered with the Company or with their respective Depository Participant(s), and who wish to receive the Notice of this EGM and all other communication sent by the Company, from time to time, can get their email address registered by following the steps as given below:

All documents referred to in this Notice and the Explanatory Statement, and requiring Members' approval, and such statutory records and registers, as are required to be kept open for inspection under the Companies Act, 2013, shall be electronically available for inspection. 13. The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Sameer Kishore Bhatnagar, Company Secretary in Practice (Membership No. A – 30997), Proprietor of M/s Sameer Bhatnagar & Company, Practicing Company Secretaries, as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the process for remote e-Voting and e-Voting at the EGM in a fair and transparent manner and they have communicated their willingness to be appointed and will be available for the same purpose.
14. The Scrutinizer shall, immediately after the conclusion of the EGM, count the votes cast through e-Voting at the EGM, thereafter unblock the votes cast through remote e-Voting and make, not later than two (02) working days in terms of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, a consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, and submit the same to the Chairman or to a person authorized by the Chairman in writing who shall countersign the same.
15. The Results declared along with the report of the Scrutinizer shall be forwarded to the Stock Exchange i.e., BSE Limited, where the shares of the Company are listed. The Results shall also be simultaneously be placed on the website of the Company at www.pgil.com and on the website of Registrar MAS Services Limited at www.masserv.com.
16. The Chairman or the person authorized by him in writing shall forthwith on receipt of the consolidated Scrutinizer's Report, declare the Results of the voting and the date of passing of result on the resolutions shall deem to be the date of the EGM.

Instructions:

1. In view of the COVID-19 pandemic, social distancing is a norm to be followed and pursuant to the Circulars, physical attendance of the Members to the EGM venue is not required and general meeting be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio-visual means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing EGM through VC/OAVM.
2. Pursuant to Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the facility to appoint a proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this EGM. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorized representatives to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM and participate thereat and cast their votes through e-voting.
3. The Members can join the EGM in the VC/OAVM mode 30 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the EGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on a first-come-first-served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the EGM without restriction on account of first-come-first-served basis.

THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING AND JOINING EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING ARE AS UNDER: -**THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:**

- i. The voting period begins on **Sunday, 11th October, 2026 at 9:00 AM IST and ends on Tuesday, 13th October, 2026 at 5:00 PM IST**. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of **Wednesday, 7th October, 2026**, may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. The voting right of shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date, being **Wednesday, 7th October, 2026**.
- ii. Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- iii. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders / retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- iv. In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

A) Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

Login method for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode is given below:

After successful authentication, you will be able to see e-Voting services under Value added services. Click on “Access to e-Voting” under e-Voting services and you will be able to see e-Voting page. Click on company name or e-Voting service provider i.e. NSDL and you will be re-directed to e-Voting website of NSDL for casting your vote during the remote e-Voting period or joining virtual meeting & voting during the meeting. 2. If you are not registered for IDeAS e-Services, option to register is available at https://eservices.nsdl.com. Select “Register Online for IDeAS Portal” or click at https://eservices.nsdl.com/SecureWeb/IdeasDirectReg.jsp 3. Visit the e-Voting website of NSDL. Open web browser by typing the following URL: https://www.evoting.nsdl.com/ either on a Personal Computer or on a mobile. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon “Login” which is available under ‘Shareholder/Member’ section. A new screen will open. You will have to enter your User ID (i.e. your sixteen-digit demat account number hold with NSDL), Password/OTP and a Verification Code as shown on the screen. EXPLANATORY STATEMENT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013, SETTING OUT MATERIAL FACTS OF THE SPECIAL BUSINESSES AS SET OUT IN ITEM NO. 1.

ITEM NO. 1:

In accordance with Sections 23, 42 and 62 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “Act”) read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014, the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 and other applicable rules made thereunder (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) and in accordance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 (the “SEBI (ICDR) Regulations”) and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the “Listing Regulations”), as amended from time to time, approval of the Members of the Company by way of **Special Resolution** is required to issue of warrants convertible in to equity shares (“Warrants”) to the Proposed Allottees, on a preferential basis, in compliance with applicable provisions of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations.

(iii) Maximum number of specified securities to be issued:

The resolution set out in this notice authorize the Board to issue up to maximum of 66,00,000 (Sixty-six Lakhs Only) number of warrants convertible in to equivalent number of equity shares at a price of Rs. 117.50/- including premium of Rs 112.50/-.

(iv) Relevant Date

In terms of the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, Relevant Date for determining the minimum issue price for the Preferential Allotment of the Convertible Warrants is **Friday, 11th September, 2026**, being the date 30 days prior to the date on which the resolution is deemed to be passed.

(v) Basis on which the Price has been arrived

The Equity Shares of the Company are listed on BSE Limited. In case of the frequently traded shares, as per Regulation 164(1) of ICDR Regulations, the minimum issue price of the equity shares in preferential issue has to be calculated as under:

- a. the 90 trading days volume weighted average price of the related equity shares quoted on the recognized stock exchange preceding the relevant date; or
- b. the 10 trading days volume weighted average price of the related equity shares quoted on a recognized stock exchange preceding the relevant date; whichever is higher.

- The allotment of equity shares are subject to the Investor(s) not having sold any Equity Shares during the 90 trading days preceding the Relevant Date.
- The Company, its Promoters and Directors are not declared as willful defaulter by Reserve Bank of India or not declared as fraudulent borrower and also not declared as fugitive economic offender.

Further, the proposed allotment is not more than 5% of the post issue fully diluted share capital of the Company to an allottee or to allottees acting in concert. Hence, Regulation 166A of ICDR Regulations is not applicable on the Company.
