UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Abhimanyu Bhandari, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner in SLP (Civil) No.23961 of 2026 and for the respondent in SLP (Civil) No.29624 of 2024 and Mr. Aditya Parolia, learned counsel for the respondents in SLP (Civil) No.23961 of 2026 and the petitioners in SLP (Civil) No.29624 of 2024.
2. The parties have favourably responded to the suggestion of the Court that an amicable solution be explored through the process of mediation.
3. Let the matter be referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. Parties to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Centre, on 11th September, 2026 at 11.00 a.m.
4. The first meeting with the Coordinator shall be virtual. The learned Mediator appointed by the Supreme Court Mediation Centre is requested to conduct the proceedings, as far as possible, through the medium of video conferencing. Considering the nature of the dispute involved in these petitions, we request the Coordinator to assign a senior mediator.

5. In the event, the learned Mediator desires personal presence of the parties, they shall undertake to appear physically.

6. Call on 20th November, 2026 after receipt of the report from the Mediator.

7. In the meantime, interim order earlier granted by this Court on 21st July, 2026 in SLP (Civil) No.23961 of 2026 shall continue to operate.
