HARPREET SINGH BRAR J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization in the light of the policy decision dated 18.06.2014 (Annexure P-1) and the petitioners be granted all consequential benefits.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that he would be satisfied if the demand notice of the petitioners (Annexure P-3) is decided by respondent/competent authority by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, submits that he has no objection, in case a direction is issued to the



respondent/competent authority for time-bound consideration and decision of the demand notice submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order.

4. Keeping in view of the limited prayer made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioners, the respondent/competent authority is directed to consider the demand notice of the petitioners (Annexure P-3) and pass a speaking order in the light of the decision rendered by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-5686-2016**, titled as ***Sukhvinder Singh and others vs State of Haryana and others***, decided on **25.05.2026** (Annexure P-4), after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of 03 months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioners. Needless to say, if the petitioners are found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted forthwith by respondent/competent authority.

5. Disposed of, accordingly.
