Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus declaring the Memo.No.SE/OP/NZB/DE(T)/PO/JAO/Adm/E2/F.No.1626/08-7, dt. 15-09-2009 issued by the 1st respondent and its connected Memo.No.CMD/CGM (HRD)/AS.DC/F.No. 1701-D1/08-20, dt. 25-01-2010 issued by the 2nd respondent is as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and disproportionate when compared with the charge and consequently hold that the petitioner is entitled to be reinstated into service as LD.C. with all consequential benefits.

**ORDER:**
