ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

15.09.2026: While the appellants submit that they have shared the information and have been cooperating with the bank and even came out with a repayment plan, the bank states there is a yawning gulf between the amount which the bank claims and the appellant's offer. Left with little option, we list the matter for final hearing.

2) The appellant is required to file a pointed notes of submission and circulate the copy well in advance to the respondent. The respondent is required to make only those points which the appellant raise. In the meantime, we require the bankruptcy trustee to file a status report.

3) We underscore that we will give 30 minutes to the appellant to make his oral submissions and 20 minutes to the respondent. The time we now allot may vary depending upon the nature of submissions that we receive.

4) List the matter on **21.09.2026** at **12:30 PM**.

5) The interim order to continue till the next date of listing.
