UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Mr. Purushottam Sharma Tripathi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the Pharmacy Council of India rejected the petitioner's application for B. Pharm Course only for the substantive reason that the petitioner failed to submit consent of affiliation by the Jharkhand University of Technology. He would further submit that the conditional NOC for commencement of the course was already granted on 09.12.2025 by the State Government. Thereafter on 09.07.2026 Jharkhand University of Technology granted consent for affiliation.
2. By our order dated 25.08.2026 in the Writ Petition (c) No.

1009 of 2026, we had extended the time for counselling. By the same order, we had directed the Pharmacy Council of India to consider and grant approval for the Academic Session 2026-2027 to certain academic institutions.

3. In view of the fact that the counselling is not yet over, as an exceptional case, we direct the Pharmacy Council of India to process the application and pass the appropriate order for grant of approval which was earlier rejected on 03.07.2026 so that the petitioner may participate in the counselling.

4. Accordingly the Writ Petition is disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
