Since the petitioner has an effective alternative remedy under the SARFAESI Act against the impugned order, and moreover the impugned order has only pointed out the defects in the application filed against the action of the respondents taken under Section 13(4) of the Act, we are not inclined to entertain the Writ Petition.

Accordingly the Writ Petition is dismissed with liberty to avail appropriate remedy.
