01. 1. Heard Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Pradhan, learned ASC for the State.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that the Opposite Parties are now proceeding for eviction of the Petitioner by loudspeaker announcement without granting her any opportunity of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Opposite Parties, particularly the Commissioner of Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation, Bhubaneswar (O.P.No.4) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner and take decision in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks



from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by O.P.No.4, the Petitioner may not be evicted from the case land.
