UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. This is a Miscellaneous application for clarification of order passed by this Court on 24.07.2026.
2. The prayer(s) made in the said application is as follows:-

*"Modify/Alter the order dated 24.07.2026 passed in Special Leave Petition(C)No.24482/2026 to the extent of substituting the figure of Rs.4,70,61,090/- with the correct/actual balance amount of Rs.3,58,48,931/- payable by the Petitioner to the Respondent."*

**3. The order dated 24.07.2026 passed in SLP(C) No(s).24482/2026 reads as follows:-**

*"1. Heard Mr. V.Chitambaresh, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Jayasree Narasimhan, learned counsel appearing for the respondent, on caveat.*

*2. We find no good grounds to interfere with the impugned order. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed. 3. At this stage, learned senior counsel for the petitioner prays for eight weeks' time to pay the balance amount due under the Award.*

*4. Ms. Jayasree Narasimhan, learned counsel for the respondent submits that, as on today, the balance amount along with interest and cost works out to approximately Rs.4,70,61,090/-.*

*5. Subject to an undertaking being filed by the competent officer of the petitioner stating that the balance payment, along with accrued interest till the date of the payment, will be paid to the respondent, the petitioner is given eight weeks from today to comply with the same. Let the undertaking be filed within one week.*

*6. Needless to say that subject to the undertaking being filed by the petitioner within the time stipulated, the respondent shall not precipitate the matter for a period of eight weeks from today.*

*7. List the matter for compliance on 23rd September, 2026.*

*8. Pending applications shall also stand disposed of."*

**4. We are of the opinion that instead of this Court mentioning any amount, the computation should be left to the Executing Court concerned.**

5. We so direct.

6. At this stage, Mr. Jogy Scaria, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once the amount is computed by the Executing Court concerned, the petitioner will pay the amount within a period of two days from the date of computation.

7. The statement is placed on record.

8. In view of that, the undertaking as mentioned in paragraph 5 of the order dated 24.07.2026 indicated above, is dispensed with.

9. We are informed that the matter is coming up on 28.09.2026 before the Executing Court concerned.

10. We direct the Executing Court concerned to dispose of the matter on 28.09.2026 itself.

11. IA No. 254958/2026 and miscellaneous application shall stand disposed of in the above terms along with pending application(s), if any.
