1. An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act”), relating to the Special Business at Sr. 4 to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting is annexed hereto. The relevant details as required under regulation 36(3) of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”) and Clause 1.2.5 of SS-2 (Secretarial Standards – 2) on General meetings by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, in respect of the person seeking appointment / re-appointment as Director, of the Notice, is also annexed.
2. Pursuant to General Circular nos. 14/2020, 17/2020, 22/2020, 33/2020, 39/2020, 10/2021, 20/2021, 3/2022 10/2022 and 09/2023 dated 8th April, 2020, 13th April, 2020, 15th June, 2020, 27th September, 2020, 31st December, 2020, 23rd June, 2021, 8th December, 2021, 5th May, 2022 28th December, 2022, 25th September, 2023 and 19th September, 2024 respectively (collectively referred to as “MCA Circulars”) and Circular Nos. SEBI/HO/ SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 and SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2CMD2/P/ CIR/P/2024/4- dated 12th May, 2020, 15th January, 2021, 13th May, 2022, and 5th January, 2023 (collectively referred to as “SEBI Circulars”) respectively issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and Securities and Exchange Board of India, the holding of the Annual General Meeting through VC/OAVM, without the physical presence of the Members has been permitted. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (‘the Act’), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (‘the Listing Regulations’), MCA Circulars and SEBI Circulars, the AGM of the Company is being held through VC/OAVM which does not require the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. The proceedings of the AGM will be deemed to be conducted at the Registered Office of the Company, which shall be the deemed venue of the AGM.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, a member entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on his/her behalf and the proxy need not be a Member of the Company. Since this AGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC/OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointments of proxies by the Members will not be available for the Annual General Meeting and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to the Notice.
4. Institutional/Corporate Shareholders (i.e. other than individuals / HUF, NRI, etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPEG Format) of its Board Resolution or governing body Resolution/Authorisation, etc., authorising its representative to attend the Annual General Meeting through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting. 5. Members attending the meeting through VC/OAVM shall be counted for the purposes of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
6. The Notice of the 44th Annual General Meeting of the Company along with the Annual Report for the financial year 2025-26 is being sent only by electronic mode to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/Depositories in accordance with the aforesaid MCA Circulars and circular issued by SEBI dated May 12, 2020. Members may note that the Notice of Annual General Meeting and Annual Report for the financial year 2025-26 will also be available on the Company’s website www.naxparlab.com and also on website of the Stock Exchanges i.e BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com. Members can attend and participate in the Annual General Meeting through VC/OAVM facility only.
7. The Register of Members and the Share Transfer Books of the Company will be closed from Wednesday, 23rd September, 2026 to Tuesday, 29th September, 2026 (Both days inclusive) for the purpose of the 44th Annual General Meeting of the Company.
8. Since the 44th AGM will be held through VC/OAVM, the route map is not annexed.

9. Members are requested to:

13. To prevent fraudulent transactions, members are advised to exercise due diligence and notify the Company of any change in address or demise of any member as soon as possible. 14. In compliance with provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013, Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended by the Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015 and Regulation 44 of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings (SS2) issued by the institute of Company Secretaries of India, the Company is pleased to provide to its Members the facility to exercise their right to vote on resolutions proposed to be considered at the 44th Annual General Meeting (AGM) by electronic means and the business may be transacted through e-Voting Services. The facility of casting the votes by the Members using an electronic voting system from a place other than venue of the AGM ("remote e-voting") will be provided by MUFG Intime India Private Limited (LI IPL).
