1. This is an application filed seeking extension of CIR period w.e.f. 11.03.2025 to 02.11.2025.
2. Our attention has been drawn to the order dated 20.02.2026 passed in IA/1425/2025, wherein, the Ld. Counsel for the RP, on his request, was given the liberty to file a consolidated application for extension of CIR period in the background of pendency of another application for extension of CIR period. The Applicant withdrew the earlier extension application and filed the instant one.
3. The Ld. Counsel for RP relies on the resolution passed by the CoC in its 11th meeting held on 19.03.2026 which has been mentioned in para 39 of the application. Ld. Counsel for the RP further submits that no Resolution Plan was received hence, the decision with regard to filing of the liquidation application has been taken and the same has been filed on 02.11.2025.
