A W A R D

1. There is already an order dated 05.08.2025 passed by this Court disposing of the Special Leave Petition and directing as under:

"5. Keeping in view aforesaid aspects, we are of the considered view that a lump sum amount or a global compensation of Rs. 4,00,000/- if awarded it would meet the ends of justice and it would be just

compensation. This would be in addition to the compensation awarded by the High Court. The enhanced compensation of Rs. 4,00,000/- would carry interest @ 6% per annum from the date of petition till date of payment or deposit whichever is earlier.

6. The respondent insurer which is liable to indemnify the claim is directed to deposit the substituted compensation with interest before the jurisdictional Tribunal within a period of six weeks from today."

2. We are informed by learned counsel for the respondent no.2 - Insurance Company assisted by Mr. Sahil Gupta, Chief Manager (Legal) of Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. that the amount has already been deposited before the concerned MACT.

3. Taking note of the submission and action taken by the respondent no. 2, no further decision needs to be arrived at in this matter.

4. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
